

remembering **GOD'S LOVE**

One of the most difficult challenges in the Christian life is to remember God's love. The following exercise can encourage your group to discover God's love and remind each other of it regularly.

First, ask for volunteers to read each passage of Scripture. Then ask how God's love was shown in each passage.

Write a brief description in the corresponding box. Finally, ask for volunteers to send reminders of each passage to the entire group via text, email, or whatever platform everyone can access. Assign a volunteer to each day of the following week. Cut on the dotted lines to send a reminder with the volunteer.
